- All entries must be quilted and submitted with finished edges and in good clean condition.
- Tied quilts, antique/vintage quilts, t-shirt quilts or pre-printed panels will not be accepted.
- Quilts must have been completed after January 1, 2010.
- Quilts must not have been displayed in previous Tulip Time Quilt Shows.
- With your entry form, submit two (2) 4"x6" photos on photo paper.
 - 1. Close up image of the quilt with details
 - 2. Image of the entire quilt
- On a separate paper, please write a brief description (no more than 3 sentences) about your quilt indicating if it is hand made or machine made, and if you did any of the design, dying or painting on your quilt.
- All entries must be pre-registered each with its own entry form. You

- Due to space restrictions, quilters are limited to three entries with only one entry exceeding a perimeter of 200".
- The Tulip Time Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to determine acceptance, placement and display.
